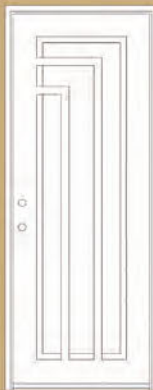
How To Read Midwest Iron Doors Serial Numbers:

- The serial numbers in this catalog are shown directly below the doors. The "Door Unit" number is the serial number for the door unit only. The "Scroll Design" number is the serial number for the interchangeable scroll panels.
- The first two numbers in the serial number denote the design of the door or scroll.
- The serial number examples in this catalog for double doors are shown as 72" wide (107296). When showing a 64" wide door substitute 64 in place of 72.
- The Letter after the scroll serial number denotes the shape of the scroll/window opening (017296A).
- When single doors are ordered and when the serial number is placed on the label the swing of the door should be included in the serial number as follows: LH114296. LH denotes Left Hinged and RH denotes Right Hinged. This will automatically make it an inswing. If outswing is needed you must note that when placing an order.

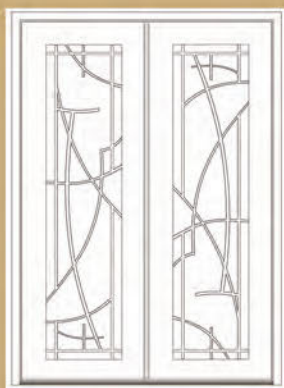

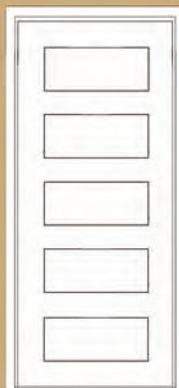

Door Panels

Interior and exterior portions of the door panel and frame are constructed of 14 gauge steel.

Scroll Work

All scroll work is constructed of 5/8" or 1/2" solid steel bar.

Stock Doors

Midwest Iron Doors maintains inventory of all design series doors. We stock 64" and 72" wide double doors. Our stock single doors are 42" wide. All stock doors are 8' in height.

Thermal Break

All of our thermally broken doors are constructed using our patent pending thermal break to allow for optimal performance in hot and cold weather climates.

Doors Without Thermal Break

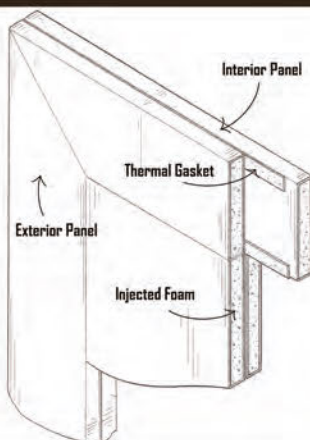
Midwest Iron Doors offers doors without a thermal break for warm climate or wine cellar applications. These doors go through the same processes as our thermally broken line. Doors without thermal break are constructed out of 2" x 6" tube steel and injected with closed cell polyurethane foam.

Paint Finish

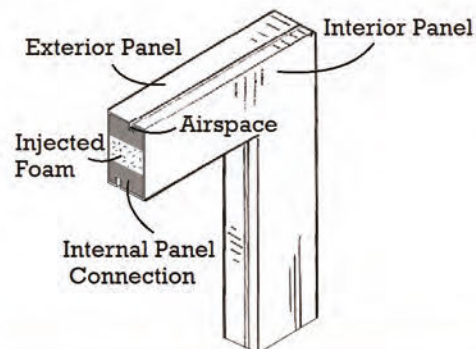
Our doors go through numerous steps to create one of the industry's most durable finish. To give the doors a unique look they receive a hand applied faux finish.

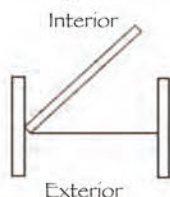
Second Generation Thermal Break



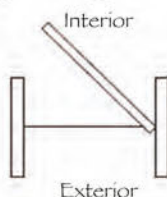

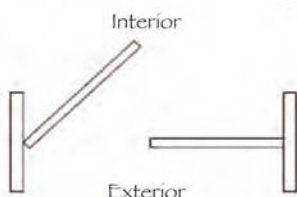


Right Hinged Inswing

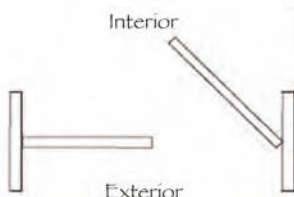


Double Door Inswing

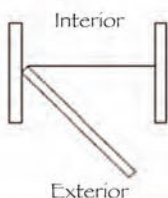

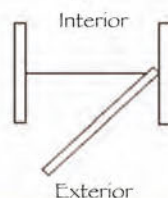

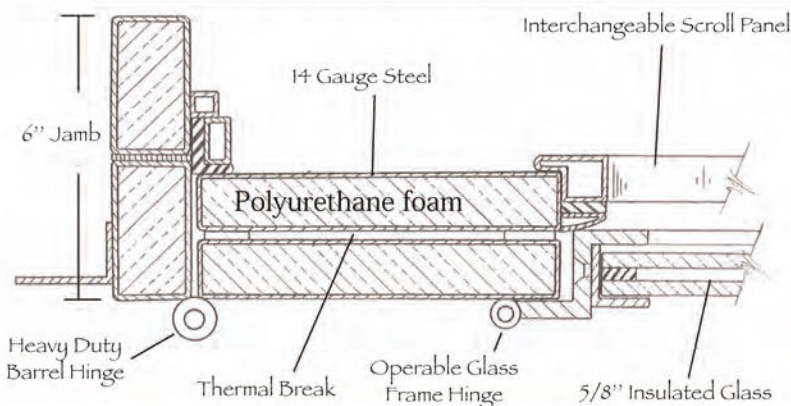

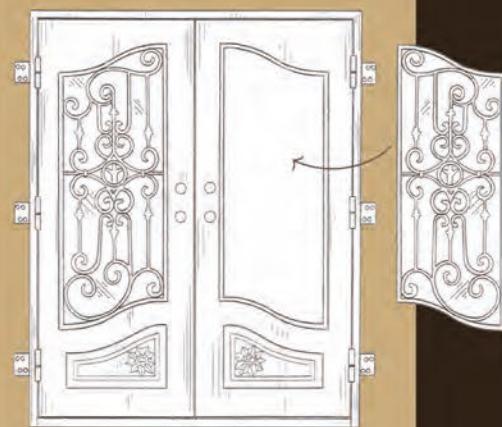
